Policies of the St. Richard Parent Club Scholar Dollars Program (SCRIP) 2014-2015

- 1. Purchases from the Scrip Program for the 2014/2015 school year will run through March. Any questions about the Scrip Program should be directed to the Scrip Program coordinators, Val Myers at 419-829-3307 and Laura Kuhlman at 419-825-2577.
- 2. Family or friends may help you with your tuition reduction by ordering certificates and noting your name on the contract they sign with the earnings directed to your family. All checks in the envelope must be made payable to St. Richard Parent Club. These checks are non-tax deductible because you receive dollar for dollar value.
- 3. The percentage earned on each participating family Account Number will be held by St. Richard Parent Club and credited to your account on next year's tuition. The dollar amount earned will be noted on your pickup envelope except for any purchased cash and carry certificates.
- 4. The Scrip Program is being offered to promote a Catholic education of students at St. Richard Parish; therefore the money collected on your account will be paid to St. Richard School for tuition for grades Preschool-8 or School of Religion. If you have no children attending either of these, the monies held under your Account can be:
 - a. Credited to another family's tuition at St. Richard School or a Toledo Diocesan School of your choice.
- b. Credited to the St. Richard School Tuition Assistance Fund (This helps families in need of scholarships with tuition)
- c. Credited to the General School Fund (This helps with operating expenses incurred by the school)
- d. Credited to a favorite teacher at St. Richard School
- e. Used toward a family's "Fundraising Fee"

If nothing is noted, it will automatically be given to the school general fund.

- 5. Certificate orders will only be given to parents unless a Disclaimer of Responsibility form has been signed. This must be done for each school year before certificates will be released to your child. These forms will be kept on file.
- 6. All completed certificate order forms may be turned in at any time, but no later than **Monday** at **Noon** if you wish to receive your order on **Friday** of that week. Orders may be turned in to the teacher, school office, collection basket at Mass, or Parish office. No late orders will be accepted. Filled orders and new order forms will be available for pickup on Friday during school hours unless you choose to pick up the order from the parish office during their hours. We reserve the right to change any incorrect dollar amount increments or issue a credit slip.
- 7. These gift certificates are just like cash. **Neither St. Richard School or the Parent Club** are responsible for lost or misplaced certificates.
- 8. Anyone writing a N.S.F. check will incur a fee of \$35.00 to be paid to the Parent Club. After two N.S.F. checks are tendered, only money orders or cashiers checks will be accepted on your account. No further personal checks will be accepted for purchase of certificates.
- 9. The Scrip Program being offered by St. Richard Parent Club uses the services of certificate broker organizations. These organizations purchase gift and merchandise certificates in large quantities at a discount from major food and retail chains. As a school organization, we are able to buy these certificates at the discount but in smaller quantities to sell at face value, thereby raising funds for the designated recipient that is chosen (see #4). Your 'rebate' ranges from 2 to 24 percent of the certificate value. 'Rebate' percentages are subject to change without notice. A complete list of stores and restaurants, along with the percentage discount the designated recipient receives is on the order form. St. Richard Parent Club and St. Richard School shares 2% of any scrip offered by our supplier which is over 5%, if the scrip offered by the supplier is 4% or less, the purchasers receive the entire percentage.
- 10. The certificates can be used, for the most part, just like cash or a check at the participating stores. Certificates have an expiration date varying from six months to two years. Some stores limit the amount of change that can be returned from a certificate purchase (see individual certificates). Do not expect any change unless it is explicitly stated so on the certificate.
- 11. In cases where the business has suddenly closed before the certificates can be used, a refund of up to \$50 will be considered by St. Richard Parent Club.
